



We strive to take all necessary safety measures and protocols in compliance with provincial and regional guidelines as well as best practices shared by our industry affiliates regarding COVID-19.

Here are the measures we've taken to help ensure the health and safety of resort guests and Hockley Valley Resort team members.

Booking

We are pleased to offer online booking at our website at www.hockley.com. Tee times are paid in full at time of booking so we can offer contactless check-in on the day of play.

Tee times are fully refundable in accordance with our cancellation policy of 24 hours' notice.

Upon Arrival

Please arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before your reserved tee time. Anyone arriving before that will be asked to wait in their respective vehicles.

Guests will be asked to complete COVID-19 screening questions and will not enter property if they are experiencing any of symptoms, have travelled outside of Canada or have been in contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case.

Players will check in with the Golf staff at the laneway on the north side of the resort. They will then be directed to carts that have been cleaned and sanitized for their use.

Please note that players are required to load their own golf bags onto golf carts.

Golfers must wear a face covering on the golf cart if riding with someone from another household.

All scorecards and pencils will be removed from public areas. Scorecards will be distributed by Hockley Valley Resort team members.

Golf Shop

Physical distancing is in effect in all areas and there is a limit of 20 guests in the shop at one time.

On Course

Ball washers and divot mix will not be on course.

Pin flags shall remain untouched by golfers and left in the cup; a pin caddy has been installed at each hole in order for golfers to retrieve their ball safely.

If a wait occurs, groups must safely physical distance until the tee deck ahead clears.

Upon Round Completion

Please remove and dispose of all personal garbage from your golf cart and return your golf cart for cleaning and sanitization.

If you wish to make a future reservation please do so online or by phone.

Best Practices

Maintain a distance of 6ft from anyone outside of your household, avoiding common greetings like handshakes and high fives.

Wash hands frequently and thoroughly for at least 20 seconds and avoid touching face and eyes with unwashed hands.

Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
